Administration & Information Services Committee – One (1) three-year term, ending 12/31/06

The Administrative and Information Services Committee (AIS) reviews policy matters of administrative and informational services such as general government and information services, communications, information technology, salaries and per diems, Class C licenses, elections, and municipal organizations. The Committee shall have the responsibility to review, discuss, and report final recommendations to City Council.

Community Development & Viability Committee - One (1) three-year term, ending 12/31/06

The Community Development and Viability Committee (CDV) reviews policy matters of community development and viability pertaining to land development and maintenance, economic development and maintenance, and infrastructure development and maintenance. The Committee shall have the responsibility to review, discuss, and report final recommendations to City Council.

Financial Services Committee - One (1) three-year term, ending 12/31/06

The Financial Services Committee (FS) discusses policy matters of budget and financial affairs. The Committee shall have the responsibility to review, discuss, and report final recommendations to City Council.

Leisure Activities Committee - One (1) three-year term, ending 12/31/06

The Leisure Activities Committee (LA) discusses policies regarding leisure activities such as: City Parks, Museum, Environmental Educational Center (EEC), Community Events and Inter-local Recreational Facilities and Programs. The Committee shall have the responsibility to review, discuss, and report final recommendations to City Council.

Public Safety Committee - One (1) three-year term, ending 12/31/06

The Public Safety Committee (PS) discusses policy matters of public safety such as fire protection, police protection, emergency medical service, traffic and pedestrian safety, emergency operations and civil defense. The Committee shall have the responsibility to review, discuss, and report final recommendations to City Council.
