The Rochester Hills City Council be making nominations at the December 3, 2003 Regular Meeting to the following Boards and Commissions:

Building Authority – One (1) six-year term, ending 12/31/09

Building Authority acquires and arranges for construction on property acquired by the City when bond sales are required. Currently, the only building covered by the Building Authority is the City of Rochester Hills Municipal Offices at 1000 Rochester Hills Drive.

Pursuant to MCL 123.955, the Articles of Incorporation set forth the name of the Authority; name(s) of the unit(s) incorporating the same; the purpose for which the Authority is created; the number, terms and manner of selection of its Officers including its governing body which shall be known as the 'Commission'. Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation of the City of Rochester Hills Building Authority, certified 2/8/85 and adopted by City Council on 2/6/85 are on file.

Canvassing Board – Two (2) four-year terms, ending 12/31/07

Established by State Election Law, the Canvassing Board certifies results following every City Primary and General election. The Board is comprised of two Republicans and two Democrats.

Historic Districts Commission – Two (2) three-year terms, ending 12/31/06

Established by Chapter 118 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Rochester Hills pursuant to State of Michigan Public Act 169 of 1970, the Historic Districts Commission (HDC) investigates requests for establishing or changing Historic Districts, approves or disapproves plans for work on resources within Historic Districts and maintains a list of potential districts.

Historic Districts Study Committee – Three (3) two-year terms ending 12/31/05

Established by City Council pursuant to Chapter 4-06, Historic Districts, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Rochester Hills, Oakland County, Michigan. The Historic Districts Study Committee serves as a standing committee to conduct duties as prescribed in the Ordinance.

Rochester-Avon Recreation Authority – One (1) three-year term, ending 12/31/06

The Mission of Rochester-Avon Recreation Authority (RARA) is to provide an extensive and varied recreational program, enhancing personal enrichment, and providing for the community's leisure needs. The activities and services include, but are not limited to, recreational and enrichment activities for all ages, youth and adult sports programs (non-competitive and competitive), and activities for special populations.

The Rochester Hills City Council will be making nominations at the December 3, 2003 Regular Meeting. Interested residents may apply by submitting a Candidate Questionnaire **no later than 5:00 PM on Friday, November 14, 2003.**
