Historic Districts Study Committee To fill the unexpired term of Peggy Schodowski ending 12/31/2010

Established by City Council pursuant to Chapter 118, Historic Preservation, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Rochester Hills, Oakland County, Michigan. The Historic Districts Study Committee serves as a standing committee to conduct duties as prescribed in the Ordinance. The majority of members shall have a clearly demonstrated interest in or knowledge of historic preservation, and shall contain representation from one or more duly organized local historic preservation organizations. Upon receipt of a request to the study committee from any person owning property in the city to establish, modify or eliminate a historic district, the study committee, after making a determination that there are reasonable grounds for such a request, shall make an investigation, hold public hearings and submit preliminary and final reports to City Council. Committee meetings are currently held on the second Thursday of every month at 5:30 p.m.

Interested residents may apply by submitting a Candidate Questionnaire <u>no later than 5:00 PM on Friday</u>, <u>April 9, 2010</u>.
