SUBMITTAL OF QUESTIONS TO VOTERS

(Option 1)

Section 2.12A COUNCIL INITIATED REFERENDUM

The Council may, on its own motion, submit any proposed ordinance to a referendum for adoption or rejection at any regular or special election, in the same manner and with the same force and effect as provided in this Charter for submission on petition. The referendum election shall be held not less than sixty (60) days from the date of the Council meeting at which the ordinance is ordered submitted to the electors.

(Option 2)

Section 2.12A ADVISORY QUESTION

The Council may, on its own motion, submit any proposed ordinance or question to the electors for an advisory vote at any regular or special election. The vote of the electors shall be advisory and not binding on the Council. The advisory election shall be held not less than sixty (60) days from the date of the Council meeting at which the ordinance or question is ordered submitted to the electors
