Dear Rochester Hills City Council,

The Lochmoor Hills Neighborhood Association is requesting City Council to pass a five year resolution, allowing the Association to apply to the USDA Wildlife Services for permits for Canada Goose nest destruction and bird round-up, if necessary. These birds are a nuisance and health risk to residents around the lake adjacent to Oakstone, Shagbark and Tartan, as well as motorists and pedestrians on nearby streets. The residents have asked the Association Board to take action to resolve this problem.

The USDA Wildlife Services requires signatures from at least 70% of homeowners or a resolution from City Council to approve the issuance of permits. With the number of homes in the subdivision, obtaining 70% of their signatures is impractical.

The Lochmoor Hills Neighborhood Association thanks City Council members for their time in consideration of this matter.
