Resolution passed by City Council regarding Local Road Initiative (Millage) was distributed.

It was noted the resolution authorized John Staran, City Attorney, to draft ballot language for 2.9213 mils for a ten (10) year period.

Committee members discussed Local Road Initiative Educational Program.

- * Ed Anzek and Roger Rousse are working on articles for Hills Herald fall issue.
- * Articles to be carefully viewed as informational and educational only.
- * Articles not promotional or one-sided.
- * Deadline for fall articles July 15, 2004.
- * Begin Press campaign with letters to the editor.
- Road condition photo informational SCADA page to be placed on Channel 55.
- * Library photo with explanation display of road conditions.
- * Communicate a clear understanding of millage money.
 - * How it affects the individual property owner.
 - * What it would cost the individual property owner.
- * Explain SAD program financial analysis; how much 100 percent over a 20-year period would cost individual property owner.
- * Local Road presentation video on channel 55 to include:
 - * Historical view.
 - * Chairperson of CDV Committee observations.
 - * Bill Costich commentary on residential road issues from a larger perspective.
- * Town hall meetings from mid-August through end of September.
- * Ms. Hill suggested:

- * Senior Citizen Town hall meetings mid-August through early September.
- * General populous Town hall meetings mid-September through October.
 - * Library Location during the evening.
 - * OPC Location during the day.
- * Placement of informational boards with graphics at the Village of Rochester Hills, Library and City Hall re: roads that are fair and poor.
- * Ms. Holder suggested Rotary and Quantis service clubs.
- Informational meeting dates to be included with sewer/water bill
- * Condense Rehmann Robson brochure in Hills Herald.
- Outside group or committee formed to help promote millage.
- * Road Contractors have an interest in promotional funding of millage:
 - * Mr. Anzek and Mr. Rousse will contact contractors.
 - * Requested account set-up for possible Contractor deposits.
- * Mr. Anzek will contact Bev Jasinski, City Clerk, regarding election law requirements.
- * Committee requested time-line for all to view and keep track.

Committee confirmed City Council agreement.

- * Committee confirmed Council members were in agreement to go forward with placing millage on November ballot.
- * City Council vote was five (5) to one (1) with Gerry Robbins opposing millage, noting Mr. Robbins opposed to the amount of millage.
- Council disagreement suggests to public that millage is not necessary.
- * Council can outline community's needs.
- * Council can bring together a proposal.

Mr. Barnett Introduced Gerry Carvey to discuss Open Space Preservation Millage Proposal.

Mr. Gerry Carvey addressed the Committee noting the following:

- * Discussed formation of an advisory group consisting of the following:
 - * Seven (7) members, appointed by Mayor and/or City Council.
- * Members would be Rochester Hills residents charged with identifying and recommend properties to Council through CDV for possible purchase.
- * Petition for grant money and determine the usage of grant money.
- * Work closely with:
 - * City of Rochester.
 - * Parks Department
 - * CDV Committee
 - * City Council
- Obligation to inform the citizens Open Space Millage is on the November ballot including:
 - * Open Space Hills Herald article to be placed in fall issue.
 - * Article to be informative only.
 - * Suggested video with Mike Hartner, Gerry Carvey on channel 55.

Failed Local Road Millage

Committee members discussed Plan B needs to be in place in case the millage fails. Ms. Jenuwine noted that the Mayor's Proposed Budget is Plan B, so there is a Plan B in place.
