General Maintenance for Historic Buildings (Workshop overview)

All buildings require ongoing maintenance, and historic houses are no exception. This workshop's participants will learn of the problems common to many older structures, how to remedy them, and how to institute a maintenance program that will prevent the need for many future repairs.

The workshop will cover general maintenance; how to assess problems; do an overall survey of the exterior of a house; general materials and details usually found in a house; how to fix general problems; and who to talk to if you have bigger problems.
