PURPOSE:

City Council authorization for a blanket purchase order to assess the roofs of the Museum and Red House, develop bid specifications and provide contract administration for the installation of new roofs for these buildings to THA Architects-Engineers, Flint, Michigan in the not-to-exceed amount of \$5,000.00.

DISCUSSION:

The cedar shake roofs on the Museum, (the white farm house), and the Red House, (the small house on the Museum grounds), are in need of repair and replacement and has been identified as CIP project PK03G. The roofs are failing and leaks are causing extensive damage to plaster and wallpaper in these historic homes. Problems with the roofs range from ice damming and leaks to poor air circulation not allowing the roofs and attic spaces to "breath" properly and dry out. In addition to the plaster and wallpaper damage, the ceiling insulation is water damaged and needs to be replaced.

The museum is seeking the services of an architect to assess the roof structures and recommend corrections and provide contract administration for the installation of the new cedar shake roofs. THA is our on-call architect and is capable of performing these tasks.

FISCAL INFORMATION:

There are funds in the 2005 Facilities budget for the replacement of these roofs, line item 631-976000 Building additions and improvements, \$57,000 for the Farm House and \$10,000 for the Red House. We are seeking additional funding for architect services to correct the problems with the roofs so we are not putting new shingles on old problems.

Budget amendments will be requested in 2004 and 2005, as THA's work will be performed in two separate fiscal years.
