Amendment to Administration & Information Services Committee *By-laws and Rules of Procedure*, Article II, Section 2 (b) to change Citizens Representatives terms from three (3) years to one (1) year increments.

..Body

**Resolved**, that the Rochester Hills City Council amends the Administration & Information Services Committee *Bylaws and Rules of Procedures* as follows:

### ARTICLE II: MEMBERSHIP

#### Section 2.

- b. Each citizen member to the Committee shall be appointed by Council and shall serve for a ~~three (3)~~ **one (1)** year term expiring on December 31 of the appropriate year.; ~~except that, of the first two appointments to the Committee, one (1) member shall be appointed for a two (2) year term and one (1) member shall be appointed to a three (3)~~

~~year term to provide for staggered terms.~~ In the event of a vacant Citizen member seat, City Council shall appoint a new Citizen member to serve the remainder of the term.
