PARKS AND RECREATION

DIVISION 3.

PROHIBITED OR RESTRICTED ACTIVITIES

Sec. 74-101. Alcoholic liquors.

It shall be unlawful for any person to bring in, have in possession, or use alcoholic liquors within a park, except that the use of alcoholic liquors may be permitted with the permission of the city council and if the park facility and/or its operator has been issued a liquor license by the state liquor control commission. The city council reserves the right to limit areas and/or times of consumption of such alcoholic liquors in parks where alcoholic liquors are permitted.
