SUBJECT: RCOC Non-Motorized Transportation Facilities Agreement

REQUEST:

To obtain City Council approval of the Road Commission for Oakland County's Non-Motorized Transportation Facilities Agreement for construction of pathways within the City of Rochester Hills.

BACKGROUND:

The Road Commission for Oakland County requires communities who construct pathways within their right-of-way to enter into a Non-Motorized Transportation Facilities Agreement. This Agreement eliminates the need for the preparation of a separate agreement for each pathway the municipality constructs. It also helps to expedite the approval process for future pathways. The Agreement is automatically renewed every four years unless terminated in writing by either party within sixty days prior to the said expiration date.

The Road Commission for Oakland County will not issue the City any new permits for the construction of pathways in their right-of-way until the Agreement has been executed.

The Agreement has been reviewed and approved by City Attorney, John Staran.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Department of Public Service recommends that City Council approves the Non-Motorized Transportation Facilities Agreement between the Road Commission for Oakland County and the City of Rochester Hills and authorizes the Mayor and Clerk to execute the agreement on behalf of the City.
