SUBJECT: Historic Districts Study Committee Citizen Representative Appointment

REQUEST:

To provide City Council Members with information for the nomination of four (4) Citizen Representatives to the Historic Districts Study Committee for two-year terms to expire December 31, 2013 and one (1) Citizen Representative to the Historic Districts Study Committee to fill the unexpired term of Murray Woolf ending December 31, 2012.

BACKGROUND:

Current Citizen Representatives, James Hannick, Dr. Richard Stamps, Sue Thomasson and LaVere Webster, whose terms expire December 31, 2011, were contacted by mail and asked to respond whether they wished to be considered for nomination and appointment for an additional two-year (2) term.

Mr. James Hannick, Ms. Sue Thomasson and Mr. LaVere Webster indicated their interest in serving for another term. Dr. Richard Stamps indicated that he would not be able to serve another term on the HDSC at this time.

Council accepted the resignation of Murray Woolf from the Historic Districts Study Committee on October 17, 2011. His term was to expire on December 31, 2012.
