**OPTION 1 - MAKE RECOMMENDATION**

*Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved* that the Administration and Information Services (AIS) Committee requests City Council waive Article IV, Salaries and Fringe Benefits for Mayor, Sections 3 and 4 of the *City Council Policy for Salaries of Department Directors and Mayor and Per Diem Fees for Boards and Commissions* and defer setting the 2006 Mayor's Salary and Fringe Benefits until such time a recommendation is received from the Administration and Information Services Committee.

*Be It Further Resolved* that the AIS Committee shall make a recommendation to City Council prior to the final approval of the 2006 budget.
