Salary Recommendation for City Council - 2006

**Resolved** that the Rochester Hills City Council concurs with recommendation of the Administration & Information Services (AIS) Committee that the compensation for the Rochester Hills City Council, in the form of a yearly salary for Fiscal Year 2006 remain the same as Fiscal Year 2005 in the amount as follows:

City Council President - \$7,850.48/year

City Council Member - \$6,577.43/year

**Further Resolved** that the City Council Members shall receive per diem compensation in the amount of Sixty Dollars (\$60.00) for attendance at any meeting, for which they are appointed as a Council Representative, in excess of Thirty-two (32) meetings per year.
