COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PROGRAM REQUEST TO WAIVE RECAPTURE

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) mandates that Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) balances not exceed 1.5 times the current program year allocation sixty (60) days prior to the end of the program year (February 28th). To help comply with this regulation, the Oakland County Board of Commissioners adopted a policy allowing communities to protect funds from their two most recent program years. Therefore, all unobligated 2003 and older funds are at risk of recapture December 31, 2005.

A community may protect unobligated 2003 funds from recapture for one additional year by requesting a waiver. **Submittal of the following information and a governing body resolution** from the community requesting a one-year deferral of recapture constitutes the Request to Waive Recapture. A separate form must be submitted for each 2003 line item.
