

William J. Windscheif is Director of the Automotive Business Unit for Huntsman LLC, a large multinational chemical and plastics producer. He is responsible for profit and loss and strategic commercial activities including sales/marketing and new product development automotive market. Before joining Huntsman in 2002, he was Global Business Vice President for Basell's Advanced Polvolefins. He responsible for key account management for the global automotive industry.
