Update on Spring Stewardship Project

Member Peterson reported that Naturalist DeVoe would be available on Saturday, April 21, 2012 from 9 a.m. to noon to assist with the spring pilot stewardship project to pull the invasive weed called garlic mustard. The project would consist of about five volunteers. Since the project is prior to the Discovery Hike, the sub-committee will determine the best site to view other invasives called buckthorn and autumn olive along with garlic mustard and have posters depicting the weeds for hikers on how to recognize them and learn how to eradicate them.

Mr. Hartner also suggested to have posters showing poison ivy.
