City Council at its regular meeting of November 30, 2005 nominated the following people to fill the seven (7) positions on the Green Space Advisory Board (GSAB):

In addition to the Candidate Questionnaires Council has previously received (indicated by an asterick -\*) included in the packet are Questionnaires for the following nominees:

The process for appointing members is as follows:

- Vice President Holder will ask if there are any additional nominees
- Vice President Holder will declare the nominations closed

- Vice President Holder will call for a Roll Call Vote and Council Members shall indicate the **seven (7)** nominees of their choice.
- Nominees receiving a vote of a majority of the Council shall be considered appointed. If seven nominees do not receive the vote of a majority of Council the nominee receiving the fewest number of votes cast for any nominee shall be dropped from the list of nominees and a vote shall be taken on the remaining nominees. Voting shall continue until seven (7) nominees receive the vote of a majority of the Council Members.
- Pursuant to the resolution adopted by Council establishing the GSAB, the initial appointments are to be staggered; four (4) members to be appointed to two-year terms and three (3) members to three-year terms, resulting in subsequent appointments occurring in alternate years. Therefore, once the seven (7) members are selected Council will need to determine which members initial terms will be two year terms and which ones will be three year terms
- When Council has determined the seven members and their respective terms, Council will need to adopt a resolution appointing the **top (7)** nominees to their respective terms on the Green Space Advisory Board (GSAB).
