Dear Chief Crowell:

This letter is in response to your request to purchase and install two tornado sirens in partnership with the Oakland County Early Weather Warning Program.

Selection of the siren's location may affect the final costs. However, the maximum cost for each new siren (with two-way monitoring capability) is expected to be \$21,000. The County's twenty-five percent share of two new sirens is \$10,500; The City of Rochester Hills' seventy-five percent share is \$31,500.

Enclosed is a purchase agreement. Once this document has been completed and returned to me I will begin the Board of Commissioners approval process, order the sirens, conduct a site visit, and coordinate the installation.
