SUBJECT: Emergency Warning Sirens

REQUEST:

City Council is requested to authorize the purchase and installation of two (2) new emergency warning sirens with two-way monitoring capability. The sirens will be purchased through Oakland County in partnership with the Oakland County Early Weather Warning Program, in the amount of \$31,500.00.

REASON FOR PURCHASE:

The emergency warning sirens will be installed near the intersections of Rochester & Avon Road and Tienken & Livernois Road. With the addition of these two new sirens, it is anticipated the City of Rochester Hills will be completely covered by emergency warning sirens.

Selection of the siren's location may affect the final cost, however the maximum for each new siren is expected to be \$21,000. Oakland County's twenty-five percent share of two new sirens is \$10,500. The City of Rochester Hills' seventy-five percent share is \$31,500.
