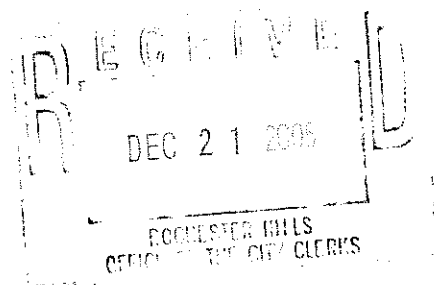

Subject: Request for consideration of issues on Council's agenda

Dear Mr. Rosen:

I would like to request the following items be addressed by the City Council at the earliest possible time:

1. At the December 14, 2005 Council meeting Mr. Duistermars had expressed his concerns regarding dispatch (911). I am not familiar with the details of the specific concern, and as such I am requesting the Administration present a report to the Council of the said matter. Additionally, a review of the 911 dispatch as to how exactly it works in our city (including which department handles what, and costs to the city) should be done by the Administration.
2. To review the status of previous Council request that City Council approve the transfer for 2006 the 0.500 mill Variance Transfer [(approximately \$1.7 million) from General Fund to the Capital Improvement Fund approved in the 2006 budget] to the Local Road Fund.
3. To consider that no Council members present a resolution for adoption at the City Council meeting without prior notice to other council members. Council members through the Council President shall give at least seven working days notice of the proposed resolution that they intend to introduce for adoption.
