SUBJECT: Change March 22nd City Council Work Session to March 29th

City Council Members have previously received information regarding the Michigan Municipal Leagues 39th Annual Legislative Conference to be held on Wednesday, March 22, 2005, in Lansing, Michigan. This is the same day Council has scheduled a Regular City Council Work Session. I am requesting Council consider changing the March 22nd Work Session to March 29th for two reasons:

1. To allow Council Members the opportunity to attend the Legislative Conference without having to leave early to attend the City Council Work Session and
2. To use the meeting on March 29th to discuss the Solid Waste Issue.

In respect to the MML Legislative Conference, we currently have two Council Members who have indicated they will be attending, and I encourage other Council Members to consider attending. As in the past the City will be taking members of the Rochester Hills Government Youth Council (RHGYC) to this event and this year ten students have registered to attend. In addition, the Council Team along with RHGYC are actively involved with the MML to provide a better Legislative Day for the students by leading one of the breakout sessions. Bryan Barnett, City Council Member, has also been asked to join Hillsdale Mayor Michael Sinclair (the youngest Mayor ever elected) in a session to discuss with the youth representatives how young people can make a difference.
