1. Parcel has historic significance	
<i>Contains a Historic District, Cemetery, Native American Feature, or other significant feature</i>	3
<i>Does not contain any historically significant characteristics</i>	0
<u>Goal: Protect Open Space/ Scenic Resources</u>	
2. Property has steep slopes	
<i>Maximum Slope = 20% or more</i>	2
<i>Maximum Slope = >=10-20 %</i>	1
<i>Maximum Slope = >= 5-10 %</i>	0
<i>Maximum Slope <=5 %</i>	
3. Parcel contains a Potential Natural Area	
<i>Contains part of an MNFI potential natural area</i>	3
<i>No MNFI potential natural area</i>	0
4. Parcel is large in size
