**Re: Traffic Study for West Middle School Ingress/Egress - Sections 16 & 17**

Dear Resident:


The City of Rochester Hills' Engineering Department will be conducting a traffic study to evaluate potential ingress and egress traffic conflicts occurring during the morning and afternoon student arrivals and dismissals, respectively. As part of the study, staff will implement a temporary traffic control order (TCO) to restrict left-turn movements from southbound Old Perch onto Ansal Drive between 7 a.m. to 8 a.m. on school days only (see sign location map on reverse).

The vehicular and pedestrian movements will be reviewed during the a.m. arrivals while the turning movement restrictions are in place. Based upon staff's evaluation, a determination will be made regarding whether the turning restrictions improve the ingress/egress to the school and help to minimize any existing left-turn traffic conflicts. If there is evidence of reduced turning movement conflicts, staff will formally present the study to the City's Advisory Traffic & Safety Board (ATSB) for further discussion. A determination will be made whether to support having the TCO implemented permanently, and to possibly include the p.m. dismissal time as well.

This study is being conducted in partnership between the City, the Oakland County Sheriff's Office (OCSO), the Rochester Community Schools (RCS), and the Traffic Improvement Association (TIA), whose common objective is to increase traffic safety and minimize conflicts where feasible at the school's entrance.

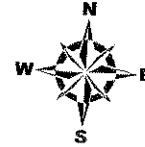

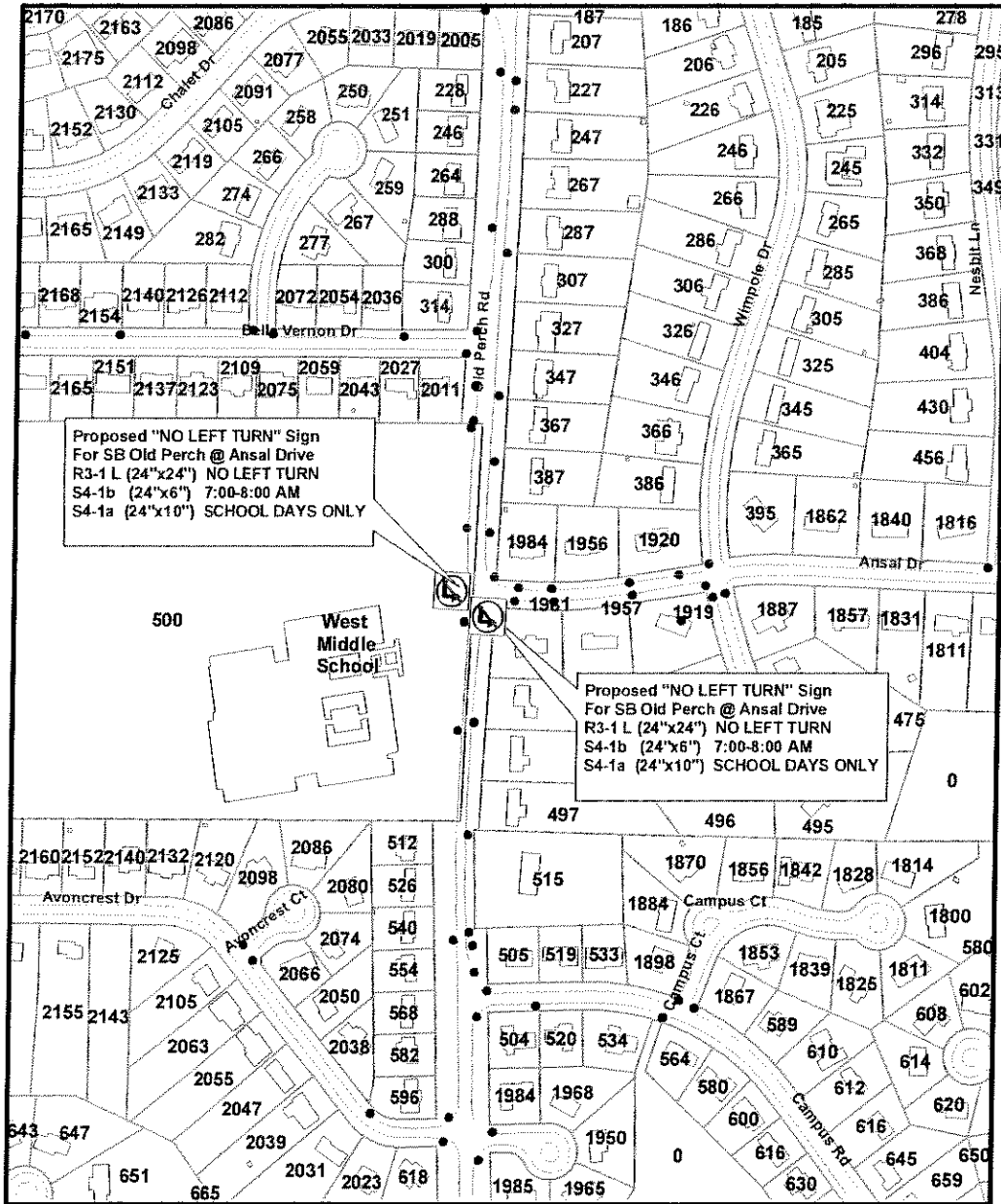
