**CONTROLLING PARKING ON CITY STREETS  
ORDER No: PK-89**

In accordance within the provisions of Chapter VI of Act No. 300, Public Acts of Michigan of 1949, as amended (Michigan Vehicle Code), and under the provisions of the City of Rochester Hills Code of Ordinances, Chapter 98 (Rochester Hills Traffic Code), as amended, we have made a traffic engineering investigation on

**Yorktowne Commons Subdivision, Section #23**

and as a result of said investigation have determined that stopping, standing or parking on said street is dangerous to those using the street and would unduly interfere with the free movement of traffic, and hereby direct that there be:

**PK-89.1**      **“No Parking”** within the right-of-way on both sides of **Yorktowne Drive** from Rochester Road to Grosvenor Drive.

This Order becomes effective when a certified copy hereof is filed with the City Clerk of Rochester Hills, Michigan and signs and/or markings in conformity with the Michigan Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices giving notice of the same have been placed and maintained.

This traffic control order shall not be effective after the expiration of 90 days from date of issuance and shall not be renewed or extended, except upon approval by City Council.
