Approval of Amendments to Green Space Advisory Board (GSAB) Guidelines for Operating Procedures

..Body

**Resolved:** That the Rochester Hills City Council amends the Green Space Advisory Board (GSAB) Guidelines for Operating Procedures as follows:

- All recommendations regarding the expenditure of millage funds to purchase property interests are to be brought forward in the form of a written report document with supporting documents. All other expenditures from the Fund are to follow the established purchasing policies and procedures of the City of Rochester Hills.
- Report may include, when deemed relevant, recommendations from the following:
  - Financial Services Committee
  - Leisure Activities Committee
  - Community Development & Viability Committee
  - Planning Commission

3. ~~Prior to approving any recommendation for expenditure of millage funds, the City Council shall conduct a Public Hearing regarding the report document recommendation in order to obtain comments from residents of the community.~~
  
4. ~~3~~ Input and recommendations from the public hearings *relevant to the GSAB activities* shall be reviewed by the Board and become a part of the final report document submitted to Council for approval.
