The City's Historic District Study Committee (HDSC) requested the opportunity to meet with the Planning Commission to discuss the study process, designation of historic resources and how that impacts development within the City.

The HDSC is a separate committee from the City's Historic Districts Commission (HDC) and reports directly to City Council. The Committee is charged with studying existing and potential districts to ensure they meet the criteria for designation in the City.
