SUBJECT: Unleaded Gasoline and Diesel Fuel

REQUEST:

City Council is requested to authorize the purchase of unleaded gasoline and diesel fuel to RKA Petroleum Companies, Romulus, Michigan and Ports Petroleum Company, Inc., Wooster, Ohio in the amount not-to-exceed \$732,460.00 through January 31, 2018.

REASON FOR PURCHASE:

The City participates cooperatively with the Michigan Intergovernmental Trade Network (MITN) for the purchase of unleaded gasoline and diesel fuel. The City of Sterling Heights, acting as the lead agency on behalf of the MITN cooperative solicited bids and received five responses. Based on the bid responses received, award of Unleaded Gasoline and Diesel Fuel was split and awarded to RKA Petroleum Companies and Ports Petroleum Company, Inc., as the lowest, responsive and responsible bidders for truck transport deliveries.

Cost for gasoline and diesel are calculated based on the Oil Price Information Service (OPIS) Daily Average for Detroit Area, plus the vendor's bid factor (delivery fee) per gallon. Below is a breakdown of pricing per gallon for truck transport deliveries of fuel. Wholesale pricing was based on the OPIS Detroit Rack Average on December 8, 2015.

^{*}For the first time ever, bids were received that reflect negative (-) factors for the truck transport deliveries. The negative factor applies only to the larger truck transport deliveries (>5,000 gallons), not the smaller volume tank wagon deliveries. These negative bid factors can best be explained as the 'sharing of a volume discount provided to the vendor from the fuel terminals. The bidders buy a high volume of fuel from the terminals and as a result, have favorable pricing agreements with the terminals. In the hope of being awarded a bid, vendors have made a business decision to pass along savings offered by the terminals in the form of a negative factor. When they receive award of a large cooperative agreement such as this one, the cooperative bid advances the vendors objective of meeting their threshold of fuel needed to secure favorable pricing from the fuel terminals.

With the award to the two lower bidders, the City has the ability to utilize favorable pricing based upon the type and quantity of fuel purchased. It also provides the City with a secondary source of fuel in the event of an emergency.

Prices charged to MITN members through the cooperative bid will fluctuate based on market conditions, but are considerably lower than consumer pump prices. Qualifying governmental entities are tax exempt, however, certain state and federal fees apply.

The cooperative purchases approximately 3,400,000 gallons of gasoline and 550,000 gallons of diesel fuel annually.
