SUBJECT: "2006" Sidewalk Replacement Program

REQUEST:

The Department of Public Service recommends accepting the bid and awarding a contract for the "2006" Sidewalk Replacement Program to A Land Construction, Inc. of Dearborn Heights, Michigan as the lowest responsive, responsible bidder in the amount of \$36,610.00 and authorize the Mayor and Clerk to execute a contract on behalf of the City.

REASON FOR PURCHASE:

On Thursday, June 8, 2006, the City received three (3) sealed bids for the "2006" Sidewalk Replacement Program. Of the three (3) bids received, A Land Construction, Inc. was the lowest responsive, responsible bidder. The bid received by A Land Construction, Inc. is approximately 35% below the engineering cost estimate shown on the attached bid tabulation. Work is expected to begin in August with the final completion date scheduled for the September 2006.

BUDGET:

Costs associated with the "2006" Sidewalk Replacement Program were identified in the 2nd quarter budget amendments under Local Road Fund.

The City will be responsible for budgeting the entire amount for the "2006" Sidewalk Replacement Program up front with sixty-four percent (64%) reimbursement from homeowners, which covers costs associated with property owner responsible for concrete flag replacement.

The Department of Public Service staff will provide construction engineering services for this project including complaint resolution, pay estimates and contract administration. An engineering consulting company will be used for inspection and material testing.
