SUBJECT: Appointment of 2010/2011 Rochester Hills Government Youth Council

City Council at its Regular Meeting of March 16, 2005 adopted Resolution RES0080-2005 establishing the Rochester Hills Government Youth Council (RHGYC) to promote youth involvement in local government through active participation and the mutual exchange of ideas and experiences. The RHGYC composition includes thirteen (13) members appointed by City Council following the established application/appointment process, which will consist of (2) representatives from each City Council District and five (5) at-large representatives.

In 2006, the second year of the RHGYC, 14 applications were received based on the interviews and qualifications of the 14, the Interview Team recommended appointed all fourteen. In 2007 the Interview Team recommended increasing the number of appointments to 15 which is where it has remained.

This year we are very pleased to mention that we received 30 applications that met the minimum qualifications to be considered. Of the 30 applications received, eleven (11) were from current Youth Council members requesting to be re-appointed to an additional term on the Council.

The established application/appointment process included the following:

- Submission of application packet by interested students which included the following:
 - Application
 - Essay Questions
 - Two Letters of Recommendation
- Interviews by the Interview Team consisting of City Council Member Vern Pixley, City Clerk Jane Leslie, City Council Coordinator Leanne Scott, and one (1) Senior Youth Representative, Sara Etienne and one (1) non-returning Youth Representative Jenna Clarkson.

All thirty students participated in the interview process. The interview team evaluated the candidates on application quality, adult references, interview and representation.

As in past years, we continue to be very pleased with the large number of students interested in serving on the RHGYC, nonetheless, it does make the final selection process very difficult. Each applicant was extremely bright and pleasant, and could bring something different and unique to the group. In the end, however, the Interview Team took into account the composition of the RHGYC (district representation), school representation and the number in each graduating year, and we are recommending to Council that they appoint fifteen students to the Youth Council again this year. The terms of office will be for one (1)

year coinciding with the school calendar year beginning on September 1, 2010 and expiring on August 31, 2010.

If all fifteen students are appointed, the representation would be as follows:

- CITY COUNCIL DISTRICTS
 - District 1 – Five (5) Students
 - 4 returning students
 - 1 new students
 - District 2 – Five (5) Students
 - 4 returning students
 - 1 new students
 - District 3 – Three (3) Students
 - 1 returning students
 - 2 new students
 - District 4 – Two (2) Students
 - 2 returning students
 - Zero new students

- SCHOOLS
 - Adams – 2 representatives
 - Avondale – 1 representative
 - International Academy – 2 representatives
 - Notre Dame Prep – 2 representatives
 - Rochester – 7 representatives
 - Stoney Creek – 1 representative

- SCHOOL GRADES 2010/2011
 - Ninth Grade - 2 students
 - Tenth Grade - 3 students (2 returning)
 - Eleventh Grade - 3 students (2 returning)
 - Twelfth Grade - 7 students (6 returning)

Application materials are available in the Clerk's Office if you are interested in reviewing them. A resolution for your consideration appointing the fifteen students is included in the packet.

Please note that at the August 9th Council Meeting the 2009/2011 RHGYC members will be providing their final report to City Council and the 2010/2011 RHGYC members will be sworn in.
