SUBJECT: Nonresidential Surcharges and High Strength Surcharges effective July 11, 2006 – First Reading to amend Ordinance Sections 54.744 and 54.745 of Article XII, Utilities, of Chapter 54, Fees of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Rochester Hills and repeal conflicting ordinances.

REQUEST:

Request that City Council accept the first reading of an Ordinance to amend Sections 54.744 and 54.745 of Article XII, Utilities, of Chapter 54, Fees, of the code of Ordinances of the City of Rochester Hills, Oakland County Michigan, to modify rates for the Nonresidential Surcharges and High Strength Surcharges and repeal conflicting ordinances (changes enclosed).

REASON FOR THE CHANGE:

Each Spring the Detroit Water and Sewage Department (DWSD) and the Oakland County Drain Commission (OCDC) determine the Industrial Surcharge and the Industrial Waste Control charges for the City of Rochester Hills non-residential sewage customers. Just recently, the OCDC has communicated the new rates effect July 11, 2006. Typically the City of Rochester Hills adjusts its ordinance to pass these charges through to the Rochester Hills users.

BUDGET:

The approval of these Nonresidential sewage Surcharges effective July 11, 2006 will continue the policy of passing allow these surcharges to end users in order to keep the overall system in good financial order.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that City Council accept the first reading of an Ordinance to amend Sections 54.744 and 54.745 of Article XII, Utilities, of Chapter 54, Fees, of the code of Ordinances of the City of Rochester Hills, Oakland County Michigan, to modify rates for the Nonresidential Surcharges and High Strength Surcharges and repeal conflicting ordinances (changes enclosed).
