PURPOSE:

City Council authorization for a blanket purchase order to Municipal Web Services, Birmingham, Michigan, for web site redesign and content management system in the amount not-to-exceed \$35,910 through April 1, 2005. The purpose of this project is to completely redesign the Rochester Hills web site and empower the employees of the city to make updates to the website.

DISCUSSION:

Once the project is completed the Rochester Hills web site will be completely redesigned. The redesign will be accomplished using templates which will give the site a common look and feel throughout the entire website. This will give the web site a more professional look and allow users to have an easier time navigating the web site. The web site will also be compliant with the current Americans with Disabilities Act standards.

Included in this project is a content management system. This allows the employees of Rochester Hills to quickly and easily make changes to the website without learning any HTML coding. Any employee who is proficient in Microsoft Word should have the technical knowledge required to post information to the web site. This should result in more information being placed on the web site and will allow residents to view the new information on a more timely basis.

Other features included in this project are list service, web polling, and streaming video. List service will allow the city to create 3 e-mail newsletters that residents may subscribe to. Web polling will allow the city to create non-scientific polls on the Internet for various issues or topics. Streaming video will also be available from the Rochester Hills web site so that the city employees could place short video messages about various topics.
