SUBJECT: Pathway Millage

The Financial Services Committee, the Community Development & Viability Committee and the Public Safety Committee held a Special Joint Meeting on Saturday, July 22, 2006 for the purpose of discussing millages, funding and possible election days. At the conclusion of the discussion regarding the Pathway Millage the consensus of the Committees was to recommend to Council that the City move forward with a ten (10) year Renewal Pathway Millage ballot proposal to be placed on the November General Election Ballot.

As part of the discussion the question came up as to whether a renewal millage could be expanded to include collector roads and trails or could it be used for matching grants for the "safe route to schools" initiative. City Attorney John Staran has been requested to further investigate this issue and provide an opinion to Council at the August 2nd meeting.

Based on the recommendation of the Committee a resolution has been prepared for Council's consideration to request the Attorney to prepare the appropriate ballot language for the placement of a Renewal Millage for Pathways for ten (10) years on the November 7, 2006 General Election Ballot. The ballot language could then be approved. A copy of the last renewal ballot language has been provided for your information.
