**Resolved** that the Rochester Hills City Council hereby approves the placement of a Renewal millage proposal for up to 0.18581 mills over the next ten (10) years on the November 7, 2006 General Election ballot for the purpose of continuing the Non-motorized Pathway Plan, for completing the next group of major sections and to link pathways to major uses.

**Further Resolved** that the City Council directs City Attorney John Staran to prepare the proposed ballot language to be reviewed and approved by City Council at a subsequent regular meeting.
