SUBJECT: Public Hearing - 2006 millage rates/levy for the FY 2007 Proposed Budget

#### **REQUEST:**

To recommend that City Council consider the 2006 millage levy/rates in accordance with Chapter IV, <u>Taxation</u>, specially Section 4.1, <u>Power to Tax and Special Revenue</u>, and Section 4.2, <u>Charter Tax Rate & Special Voted Millages Unlimited</u>, to be levied in December 2006 to provide the tax revenues included in the 2007 Proposed Budget and authorize the Assessor/Treasurer to have said amounts on the 2006 Tax Rolls.

### **BACKGROUND:**

Due to the November 7, 2006, election having the Pathway replacement ballot proposals potentially affecting the 2006 millage levy, the total millage is not known at this time. Based on Budget Workshop discussions, the City Council consensus appears to establish a millage rate of 9.5202. Should the replacement Pathway millage request pass in November, the 9.5202 millage rate will increase to 9.7060.

Pursuant to the requirements of the State Tax Commission, municipalities must file State form L-4029, tax rate request, with the Oakland County Department of Equalization by October 1, 2006. The city is also required to file form LT-1, Annual Report of Taxes, with Oakland County on or before October 1, 2006. Should the replacement Pathway millage request pass in November, the County will be immediately notified of the millage change.
