NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT THE ROCHESTER HILLS CITY COUNCIL will hold a PUBLIC HEARING on the **property tax millage rates proposed to be levied to support the fiscal year 2007 proposed budget**, which was submitted by the Mayor to City Council, in accordance with the Charter, at its August 2, 2006 meeting.
