**SUBJECT:** Energy Efficient Products and Electrical Contractor Services

#### **REQUEST:**

City Council authorization for a Blanket Purchase Order for energy efficient products and electrical contractor services for replacement at City facilities to Design and Quality Electric, Inc., Rochester, Michigan, in the amount not-to-exceed \$69,803.00.

### **REASON FOR PURCHASE:**

The City received American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) funding under the Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant (EECBG) to upgrade specific City buildings for increased performance, reduction of energy consumption and limitation of carbon emissions. The projects identified in the grant and included in the Request for Proposals are:

Borden Park: Replacement of Parking Lot Lights

City Hall: Replacement of Parking Lot Lights, Flood Lights and Top Light Luminaries

DPS/Garage: Replacement of Parking Lot Lights

Fire Station #1 Replacement of Recessed Lay-In Fixtures and Lamps
Fire Station #3 Replacement of Recessed Lay-In Fixtures and Lamps
Fire Station #4 Replacement of Recessed Lay-In Fixtures and Lamps

Replacement lighting will be Energy Star Rated induction type fixtures and lamps meeting the requirements of the Department of Energy and the ARRA guidelines, including Buy American. It is anticipated that the City will achieve energy savings of \$10,000 to \$18,000 per year based on reduced electrical usage.

Request for Proposals were solicited and proposals were evaluated by Mark Vecellio, Electrical Inspector, Scott Cope, Director of Building Department and Jean Farris. Design and Quality Electric, Inc. was selected as providing the lowest cost and overall best value for the City. Design and Quality Electric, Inc. has an exceptional history of service performance for the City. The project must meet the Davis Bacon provisions for labor and other mandated Federal requirements and reporting attached to the ARRA funding.

All expenses incurred are to be funded entirely through monies received in the Federal (ARRA) EECBG program. A third quarter 2010 Budget Amendment shall be forthcoming to recognize the expenses and revenues incurred.
