Please find attached one (1) hard copy and one (1) CD copy of the final version of the update to the City of Rochester Hills' Master Thoroughfare Plan (MTP). The City's Planning Commission formally adopted the MTP on October 21, 2008.

As previously discussed at the meeting held at your offices on April 16, 2008, the City's updated MTP identifies Dequindre Road as one of the primary corridors for future road improvements. Since this corridor has multi-jurisdictional boundaries including three (3) local communities and two (2) county road agencies, it will require significant coordination amongst the various stakeholders to move this project forward.

Thus far, the Road commission for Oakland Count (RCOC) has identified the segment of Dequindre from Long Lake to Auburn Road for improvements to a five-lane roadway. Federal funding for this portion is currently projected to be available in 2014 for the right-of-way acquisition phase of the project. The City would like to begin coordination with the various agencies and be able to be in a position to submit a formal funding request for federal dollars in 2010, and to include the Dequindre Road corridor in the next update to the *Transportation Improvement Program for Southeast Michigan (T.I.P.)* through the *Southeast Michigan Council of Governments (SEMCOG)*.
