

Lt. Smith provided a brief update. The Attorney General does not intend to answer questions Oakland County posed regarding Public Act 102. Lt. Smith's recommendation to the City is the O.C.S.D. wants to err on the side of caution and balance students with safety issues, noting there is a great deal of liability involved for failure to act or respond to a threat.
