Title

2008 4th Quarter Budget Amendment / Appropriations

Body

Whereas, in accordance with the provisions of Public Act 2 of 1968, the Uniform Budgeting and Accounting Act, and the Charter for the City of Rochester Hills, Chapter III Section 3.7, the City Council may amend the budget during the fiscal year, either on its own initiative or upon recommendation of the Mayor; and

Whereas, in accordance with Section 19 of Public Act 2 of 1968, the Uniform Budgeting and Accounting Act the City Council may permit the Mayor to execute *adjustments* to the budget within

limits;

Whereas, the Public Hearing for the proposed 2008 4th Quarter Budget Amendments was noticed on *November 20, 2008*; and

Whereas, the proposed 2008 4th Quarter Budget Amendments were available for public viewing beginning on <u>December 5</u>, 2008; and

Whereas, at its <u>December 15, 2008</u> meeting City Council held a Public Hearing on the proposed 4th Quarter Budget Amendments.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved that the Rochester Hills City Council hereby approves the following 2008 fund totals as amended:
