**SUBJECT:** Fuel Management System

#### **REQUEST:**

City Council is requested to authorize a project budget for the purchase of a fully automated fuel management system to Trak Engineering, Tallahassee, Florida; and various other vendors in the amount not-to-exceed \$30,000.

### **REASON FOR PURCHASE:**

The intent of the fuel management system is to obtain software and equipment that will improve the efficiency, security, and control over fuel dispensing operations.

The City solicited Request for Proposals for a fully automated fuel management system. Three proposals were received and evaluated by DPS, MIS and Purchasing staff. Two shortlisted firms presented equipment and software demonstrations to the evaluation team. Trak Engineering was selected as providing the best value to the City based on its functionality, ease of use, cost and the ability of the software to integrate with the City's RTA Fleet Management Software, Oracle/J.D. Edwards Financial Management Systems and the Veeder-Root TLS-350 tank level monitoring system.

The project budget in the amount of \$30,000 includes the cost of software, implementation, training, maintenance and support for 2 years, and additional hardware components needed to implement a fully automated fuel management system.
