SUBJECT: Request for an Extension of the Tentative Preliminary Plat for Grace Parc, City File No. 04-011, a 16-lot subdivision located north of South Boulevard, east of Livernois

REQUEST:

Approval of an Extension of the Tentative Preliminary Plat until April 20, 2013 for Grace Parc, a 16-lot subdivision located north of South Boulevard, west of Hazelton, east of Livernois, connecting to McComb.

BACKGROUND:

The Planning Commission recommended approval of the Tentative Preliminary Plat on March 15, 2005 and City Council approved it on April 20, 2005. The approval expired after one year and four Extensions were granted by City Council, the fourth one on April 12, 2010 until April 20, 2011. The development has new owners, who purchased it in 2010, and are requesting their second Extension while going through Final Plan review. Staff met with the owners and explained the process, the new Engineering standards and what the City's Extension Policy required. The applicant submitted a signed letter, attached, recognizing that they will have to bring the plat into compliance with any new Engineering standards put in place since the plat was first approved. There is sufficient escrow, taxes are paid up to date, and all policy standards have been met.

The matter was reviewed by the Planning Commission on June 5, 2012, and the Commission recommended approval of the Extension on a unanimous vote.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff and the Planning Commission recommend approval of an Extension of the Tentative Preliminary Plat for Grace Parc, City File No. 04-011 until April 20, 2013. (The date aligns with the original date of approval.)
