**SUBJECT:** Appointment of 2016/2017 Rochester Hills Government Youth Council

---

City Council at this Regular Meeting of March 16, 2005 adopted Resolution RES0080-2005 establishing the Rochester Hills Government Youth Council (RHGYC) to promote youth involvement in local government through active participation and the mutual exchange of ideas and experiences. The RHGYC composition included thirteen (13) members appointed by City Council following the established application/appointed process, which consisted of (2) representatives from each City Council District and five (5) at-large representatives.

In 2006, the second year of the RHGYC, 14 applications were received. Based upon the interviews and qualifications of the 14, the interview team recommended all 14 be appointed. In 2007, the Interview Team recommended increasing the number of appointments to 15, which is where it has remained.

This year we are very pleased to mention that we received thirty-three (33) applications that met the minimum qualifications to be considered. Of the thirty-three (33) applications received eight (8) were from the current Youth Council members requesting to be reappointed to an additional term on the Council.

The established application/appointment process included the following:

- Submission of application packet by interested students which included the following:
  - Application
  - Essay Questions
  - Two Letters of recommendation
- Interviews by the Interview Team consisting of City Council Vice-President Mark Tisdel, Senior Youth Council Member Alexis Smith and Youth Council Liaison Garren Griffith.

Twenty-five (25) students participated in the interview process. The interview team evaluated the candidates on application quality, adult references, interview and representation.

As in the past years, we continue to be very pleased with the large number of students interested in serving on the RHGYC; nonetheless, it does make the final selection process very difficult. Each applicant was extremely bright and pleasant, and could bring something different and unique to the group. In the end, however, the Interview Team took into account the composition of the RHGYC district representation, school representation and the number in each graduating year, and we are recommending to Council that they appoint fifteen students to the Youth Council again this year.

The terms of office will be for one (1) year coinciding with the school calendar year beginning on September 1, 2016 and expiring on August 31, 2017.

If all fifteen students are appointed, the representation would be as follows:

  - District 1 – Four (4) Students
    - 1 returning student
    - 3 new students
  - District 2 – Four (4) Students
    - 1 returning student
    - 3 new students
  - District 3 – Three (3) Students
    - 3 returning students
  - District 4 – Four (4) Students
    - 3 returning students
    - 1 new student
  
- SCHOOLS
  - Rochester – 5 representatives
  - Adams – 3 representatives
  - Marian High School – 2 representative
  - Stoney Creek – 1 representative
  - International Academy – 1 representative
  - Avondale – 1 representative
  - Detroit Country Day – 1 representative
  - Oakland Christian School – 1 representative
  
- SCHOOL GRADES 2016/2017
  - Ninth Grade – 2 students
  - Tenth Grade – 2 students
  - Eleventh Grade – 5 students
  - Twelfth Grade – 6 students

Application materials are available in the Clerk’s Office if you are interested in reviewing them. A resolution for your consideration appointing the fifteen students is included in the packet.

Please note, at the August 8<sup>th</sup> Council Meeting the 2015/2016 RHGYC members will be providing their final report to City Council and the 2016/2017 RHGYC members will be sworn in.
