Background

HOA Comments

- Want control over spending
- Shorter duration (10 years) preferred
- Multiple solutions to solve the police funding situation
- HOAs want to be engaged in the education process

Status Quo

- 57 Officers (56 projected 2014+) next 10 years
- 3.708 mills funds status quo

Funding Option – Maintain Status Quo

Millage

- A. Renew expiring Police Funding Millage – 1.708 mils
- B. Request New Police Millage – 2.5 mils
 - Maintains current police funding
 - 10 year duration

Charter Amendment

- A. Request Amendment to Fund Police up to 3.7 mils
 - Maintains current police funding
 - Permanent
 - Requires vote to change

City Council commitment to reduce General Fund spending by 2.5 mils

Quality of Life Improvement Options

1. Fund up to 8 additional officers - .4 mil
 - Add School Liaison Officers
 - Add Neighborhood Watch (Community Policing) Officers
 - Maintain/Enhance Response Time
2. Other non-Police funding options being considered
 - Based on HOA feedback
