SUBJECT: Public Hearing: 2011 Proposed Budget and 2010 Millage Rates

REQUEST:

We are requesting that City Council conduct a public hearing for the FY2011 Proposed Budget and FY2010 millage rates (to be levied in December, 2010), which are estimated to provide the tax revenues to support the expenditures in the FY2011 Proposed Budget (in accordance with the City Charter Section 3.1 <u>Budget Procedure and General Finance</u>, Section 3.6 <u>Adoption of a Budget</u>, Section 4.1 <u>Power to Tax and Special Revenue</u>, and Section 4.2 <u>Charter Tax Rate & Special Voted Millage(s) Limitation</u>).

BACKGROUND:

The millage(s) listed below are projected to generate the tax revenues to support the FY2011 Proposed Budget. City Council has scheduled a public hearing to discuss the proposed rates as well as the FY2011 budget proposal on September 13, 2010. City Council adoption and authorization of the millage rates listed below are proposed for the meeting of September 13, 2010 following the Public Hearing.
