During this period of time we have found that our over population of Canadian Geese has been drastically reduced. Also, during this time we have engaged in harassment methods, exclusion techniques and habitat modification in accordance within the guidelines and recommendations of the Michigan DNR.

In order to continue the Canadian Goose Nest Destruction Program we would urge the Rochester Hills City council to pass a five year resolution from 2012 to 2016.
