REQUEST:

That the Rochester Hills City Council approves the Rights-of-Way (ROW) acquisition for the Hamlin Road, (Livernois to Crooks) Project and authorizes payments to the land owners as indicated on the attached spreadsheet in an amount of \$351,073.00

REASON FOR PURCHASE:

On January 7, 2008, City Council approved a contract between the City of Rochester Hills and Hubbell, Roth & Clark, Inc. (HRC) to acquire ROW for the Hamlin Road (Crooks to Livernois) Project. Since that time, HRC has been in the process of acquiring ROW and must meet a strict deadline in order for the City to receive Federal Funding for the project. The attached spreadsheet indicates to date the purchase orders that have been executed with the landowners.
