**SUBJECT:** 2011 SCADA System Maintenance Contract, City File #E10-015

### **REQUEST:**

City Council is requested to approve a \$60,000.00 blanket purchase order for Perceptive Controls, Inc. to cover professional service costs for maintaining the Rochester Hills Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA) system.

# **REASON FOR PURCHASE:**

The SCADA system technology gives City public works staff the ability to monitor and make remote adjustments to the operation of the public water and sewer utilities. This system's importance is second only to the trained public works staff for insuring efficient and reliable water and sewer service is being provided to the City residents and businesses.

In 2009, Perceptive Controls, Inc. completed an upgrade to the City SCADA system to update software licenses, system hardware and improve the data reporting function. The SCADA system value depends on its ability to be kept current with software upgrades and programmed replacement of key hardware such as data collection servers. Approval of the attached maintenance contract from Perceptive Controls, Inc. through this blanket purchase order request will assist the continued efforts to provide a quality water and sewer service to the City customers.

### **Vendor Name and Address:**

#### **Reason for Selection:**

The initial SCADA system upgrade selection was made with a Request for Proposals process and a qualifications based selection. Although not awarded as part of the initial upgrade contract, the company selected for the upgrade was also expected to be able to provide future maintenance contract services.
