Dear Jane:

Pursuant to our telephone call earlier today, the following should assist in the approval of the transfer of the stock ownership in Palace Sports & Entertainment, Inc. (the "Palace"), which holds the Class C License located at Oakland University, Meadow Brook Music Festival. Butzel Long represents Jonathan S. Aaron and Eric L. Garber, as Personal Representatives of the Estate of William M. Davidson (the "Estate") and as Trustees of to the William M. Davidson Trust dated September 24, 2008, as amended (the "Trust").

William M. Davidson died on March 13, 2009. Prior to his death, Mr. Davidson and D Management Group, LLC were the sole stockholders of the Palace. Mr. Davidson was the sole member of D Management Group, LLC.

Mr. Davidson's ownership interests in the Palace and in D Management Group, LLC are currently held by the Estate. Mr. Davidson's Last Will and Testament provides that the residue of his estate, including the stock of the Palace he owned individually and his ownership of D Management Group, LLC, will be distributed to the Trust. The Trust will hold the entire interest of the Palace following transfer of the shares to the Trust.

As indicated in our phone call today, the Class C License for Meadow Brook Music Festival continues to be held by the Palace and no substantive changes have occurred at the Palace following Mr. Davidson's death. As a result, you indicated that answers to a majority of the questions contained in the City's Class C Liquor License Application

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were not required. In addition, you indicated that the fingerprint requirements and license transfer fees would also not be required.

I have preliminarily enclosed in this letter the first page of the City's Class C Liquor License Application with the attachment disclosing the names and addresses of the Officers and Directors of the Palace. If any additional information is required for the next City Council meeting, please let me know.

Thank you for your attention to this matter. Please contact me should you have any questions.
