

Section 7.4            TERM OF OFFICE    \*(Amended November 7, 1995)

The term of office of Council Members shall be four (4) years commencing on the second Monday next following the date of the regular City election at which they were elected. At each regular City election two (2) District positions shall be elected. Two (2) At-Large positions shall be elected at a regular City election and the other At-Large position shall be elected at the next regular City election.

Section 7.5            JUDGE OF QUALIFICATIONS OF MEMBERS

The Council shall be the judge of the eligibility and qualifications of its own Members, subject only to review by the courts.

Section 7.6            REMUNERATION OF MEMBERS OF THE COUNCIL

Each Council Member shall receive remuneration for service to the City for each meeting attended. The amount shall be established by the Council.

Section 7.7            PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL

The Council shall, at its first regular meeting in December of each year, elect one (1) of its Members to serve as President. The President shall preside over the Council and shall be the Mayor pro-tem of the City as provided in Chapter VIII.

Section 7.8            VACANCIES

When a vacancy occurs on the Council, the Council shall appoint a replacement within thirty (30) days of the vacancy by a majority vote of the Council. Such appointment shall not be subject to mayoral veto. The replacement shall serve until the next regular City election at which time there shall be elected an individual to serve the remainder of the unexpired term, if any.
